Losing your hair as a result of cancer treatment can be very challenging, and many people find that a well-fitting wig can provide a greater sense of self-confidence during this time.

If you are currently experiencing hair loss or thinning as a result of cancer treatment you may like to take the opportunity to be fitted with a synthetic wig. The Cancer Resource Nurse will help you choose a wig, fit it correctly and provide advice on wig maintenance and care. You are welcome to bring someone with you for support. The wig library requires a deposit of \$50 to hire a wig. The \$50 will be refunded when the wig is returned.

You can also purchase a wig stand, hair brush, shampoo and conditioner for \$15.
